Intellectual Property Policy

- Inbound Contributions.** Members acknowledge and agree that all new inbound code contributions to the fd.io Project (the “fd.io Project”) by a Member shall be made under the Apache License, Version 2.0 (available at <http://www.apache.org/licenses/LICENSE-2.0>). All contributions shall be accompanied by a Developer Certificate of Origin (“DCO”) sign-off (<http://developercertificate.org>) that is submitted through a Board of Directors approved contribution process (i.e., the contribution processes as described in this document or such changes thereto as may be approved by the Board of Directors from time to time). Such contribution process will include steps to also bind non-Member Contributors and, if not self-employed, their employer, to the licenses expressly granted in the Apache License, Version 2.0 with respect to such contribution.
- License and Attribution.** Contributions will be accompanied by: (a) license and copyright attribution information for each file where possible to include such information in the file; (b) any additional license compliance information required to be provided in conjunction with outbound distribution of a contribution; and (c) information sufficient to provide notice of license terms for all additional third party copyrightable components (software, graphics, text, etc.) introduced as dependencies to the submitted source code. Information regarding contributors and DCOs will be captured and preserved at the time of contribution. Specific processes for review of inbound contributions, and any changes or updates to such process (the “Review Process”), shall be approved by the Board of Directors and the oversight and implementation of the Review Process shall be the responsibility of the Legal Committee of the Board of Directors.
- Outbound Code.** All outbound code will be made available under the Apache License, Version 2.0.
- Documentation.** All documentation will be contributed to and made available by the fd.io Project under the Creative Commons Attribution 4.0 International License (available at <http://creativecommons.org/licenses/by/4.0/>).
- Exception Policy.** If an alternative inbound or outbound license is required for compliance with the license for a leveraged open source project or is otherwise required to achieve the fd.io Project’s mission, the Board of Directors may approve the use of an alternative license for specific inbound or outbound contributions on an exception basis. Any exceptions must be approved by a two-thirds vote of the entire Board of Directors and must be limited in scope to what is required for such purpose. Please email licenses@fd.io to obtain exception approval.
- Registration of Marks.** Subject to available Project funds, the fd.io Project may determine the availability of, and register, trademarks, service marks, and/or certification marks, which shall be owned by the fd.io Project.
